From then on we all spoke just one language

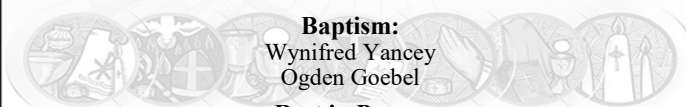
